This per-call rate is a descriptive snapshot. Change detection uses the share of matched questions holding the majority verdict, not a test of this tile's raw rate.

Read the interval, not the point. It is computed over your **40 buyer questions**, not over the 230 samples: repeats of one question are correlated, so counting them as independent samples makes the interval narrower than the data supports. On this scan a question's 6 answers are 3 samples on each of 2 engines, pooled: the interval treats them as one question's worth of evidence, and they are worth about 1.7 independent samples, not 6 — an effective sample size of 68, not 230. This scan's own repeat-to-repeat noise, measured **within each engine** — which is what a repeat is: OpenAI 33 of 40 questions gave the same verdict on every repeat, so 18% disagreed with themselves; Perplexity 32 of 39 questions gave the same verdict on every repeat, so 18% disagreed with themselves. Separately, and it is a different quantity: the 2 engines disagreed with **each other** on 10 of the 40 questions they both answered (25%). That is disagreement between two populations, not one engine's repeat noise, and it is not the number the interval above is built on. Published estimates put the noise floor of AI-citation measurement at 3–7 points (arXiv:2603.08924, head domains) — context for the measured number above, not a substitute for it.

What this scan says

- FanBell was recommended in 53 of 230 judged answers (23%) (question-resampling sensitivity range 13–33% across 40 questions), across 40 frozen buyer questions on 2 engines.
- Beacons was recommended more often than you on the same questions (54% against your 23%).
- You were never recommended for 24 of the 40 questions. A further 15 were recommended on some repeats but not on a majority — those are the questions closest to flipping.
- By question type you are weakest on “Versus / alternatives” (16% of 57 judged answers) and strongest on “Is it worth it / cheapest” (33% of 18).
- All 4 engines we check for reachability can reach your pages, so nothing in this report is explained by a blocked crawler.

Ordered by reach first, then by how little permission the move needs. **Reaches** counts your own buyer questions — for an off-site move it is the widest single page in that group, because two pages cited for the same question cannot be added together. There is no predicted change column: this report measures what the engines answered, and a projection of what a fix would do to that is not something it can honestly print.

Each engine's interval is computed over the questions that engine answered. The engines are separate populations and do not agree with each other — published cross-model agreement is 14-42% (arXiv:2609.04047) — so an engine's rate is never evidence about another engine.

Sampled (2): OpenAI, Perplexity — every number on this page is measured on them, 3 samples of each question on each. **Reachability-checked only (2):** Google AI Overviews / AI Mode, Claude — we check whether their crawler can read your pages and we report no rate for them, because their APIs do not return an attributable recommendation.

By question type you are weakest on “Versus / alternatives” (16% of 57 judged answers) and strongest on “Is it worth it / cheapest” (33% of 18). These four types are the shapes buyer questions come in, and each one is answered by a different kind of page: a "best X for Y" question is won by a page that names the segment, a "versus" question by a comparison page. Rates here are over each type's own judged answers, so a type with few questions moves easily — the counts are printed beside them for exactly that reason, and no interval is computed on a subset this small.

Can the engines read your site?

pass All 4 engines we check can reach your pages — 6 page(s), no blocking gate found. Each engine is judged against its own published rule, fetched once with that engine's crawler user-agent and once as a browser (a firewall can answer the two differently), and every gate is tagged official / observed / our inference. robots.txt parsed.

▼ Engine-by-engine detail

We check whether each engine's crawler can reach your pages. We only **sample answers** from the engines named in the header (OpenAI and Perplexity); Google AI Overviews / AI Mode and Claude are checked for reachability only, and no number on this page is measured on them.

Reachable = the robots rules allow this engine's search crawler and a fetch with its user-agent returned the page. It shows what the crawler would receive; it is not proof that the engine has crawled or indexed the page.

► Per-page detail

Each engine is judged on its own rules. The 4 MB size gate is **ChatGPT's alone** — over 4 MB — observed limit of ChatGPT's fetcher (RESONEO, 2026) (observed·RESONEO2026); Google's documented "first 2 MB" (Googlebot docs) appears as a note on the page, never as a failure (official·Google). Each page is fetched with the crawler's user-agent: that shows what a crawler *would* receive from your server, not proof that the engine crawled the page (our inference).

Deliberately not scored: schema.org / JSON-LD (matched difference-in-differences on 1,885 pages: AI Overviews -4.6%, others flat; ChatGPT strips JSON-LD before the model sees the page) (observed (Ahrefs DiD 2026)); llms.txt (97% of existing files are never fetched; Google says it ignores them) (observed (Ahrefs)); IndexNow (no Google support and no AI engine documents using it) (official (Google)); FAQ / Q&A re-formatting (controlled tests show no gain; Q&A format -5.7% absorption) (observed (arXiv:2604.25707)).

The engines already lean on third-party rankings that list your competitors. New pages on your own site move little here; the work is getting onto those third-party pages and making your existing pages the ones they cite.

83% of citations go to third-party pages · 50% to ranking pages · 42% to ranking pages that already name a tracked competitor.

15 of 40 questions are unstable (amber): they came out differently on different repeats, so their verdict is the engine's own noise as much as a result. Read as a band across your questions: **2–40%** — the low end is the share of questions recommended on every repeat, the high end the share recommended at least once.

Rewording a question changed the recommended rate by 14 points on average — questions where the two wordings disagree are marked; treat those as less stable. Measured on 40 question(s) asked in both wordings (about 4 judged sample(s) of the original and 2 of the paraphrase each), so a single question's difference is coarse. For scale, on the original wording alone 10 of 40 question(s) (25%) already disagreed with themselves between repeats: only sensitivity above that is the phrasing rather than the engine's own noise. Query wording explains far more of the variance in AI answers than brand identity does (arXiv:2607.13304: 26.5% vs 1.5%), which is why we ask twice. That baseline pools the 2 engines, so it carries between-engine disagreement as well as one engine's repeat noise; the per-engine repeat noise is stated above.

Which of your pages answers each question

We crawled **30** of your pages, simulated 283 retrieval sub-queries for your 40 buyer questions, and matched them page by page. Every question below is **ranked within this scan** by how close your own best page comes to it, and each one carries what that page is missing.

This is a ranking, not a score: the numbers are cosines between simulated sub-queries and your page text (text-embedding-3-small), they are on this site’s own scale, and there is no cut point at which a page becomes “covered”. We do not publish one, because on our own scans no fixed value means the same thing on two sites. What is measured, not inferred, is the **lacks** column: a price, figures, a comparison or numbered steps are either on the page or they are not. How much the ranking is worth on this scan: questions you were recommended for had median similarity 0.560, questions you never were had 0.531 — AUC 0.684 where 0.50 is no separation at all (moderate). Similarity separates the two groups somewhat on this site. Still an ordering to work through, not a prediction.

Simulated fan-out: no engine publishes the sub-queries it actually issues, so these are modelled with gpt-4.1-mini and frozen with your question set.

With 40 matched questions, this comparison has limited power and is mainly able to detect large, directionally consistent changes. Under the planning assumptions used here — 80% power, a two-sided 5% test and an assumed 20% of questions disagreeing between the two scans — a change of about 20 points has about 80% power in one primary comparison. This is not a cutoff: smaller changes can sometimes be detected, and larger changes are not guaranteed to be detected. Two AI judges agreed on 39 of 40 sampled answers ($\kappa=0.95$; approximate nominal 95% interval 0.85–1.00). This measures agreement between two related AI models, not accuracy against a human gold standard. Human validation is not yet complete. This report is measurement evidence, not attribution: a change detected between two scans does not on its own show that a change to the site caused it.
